Authentic and latest crime statistics released by FBI show that:

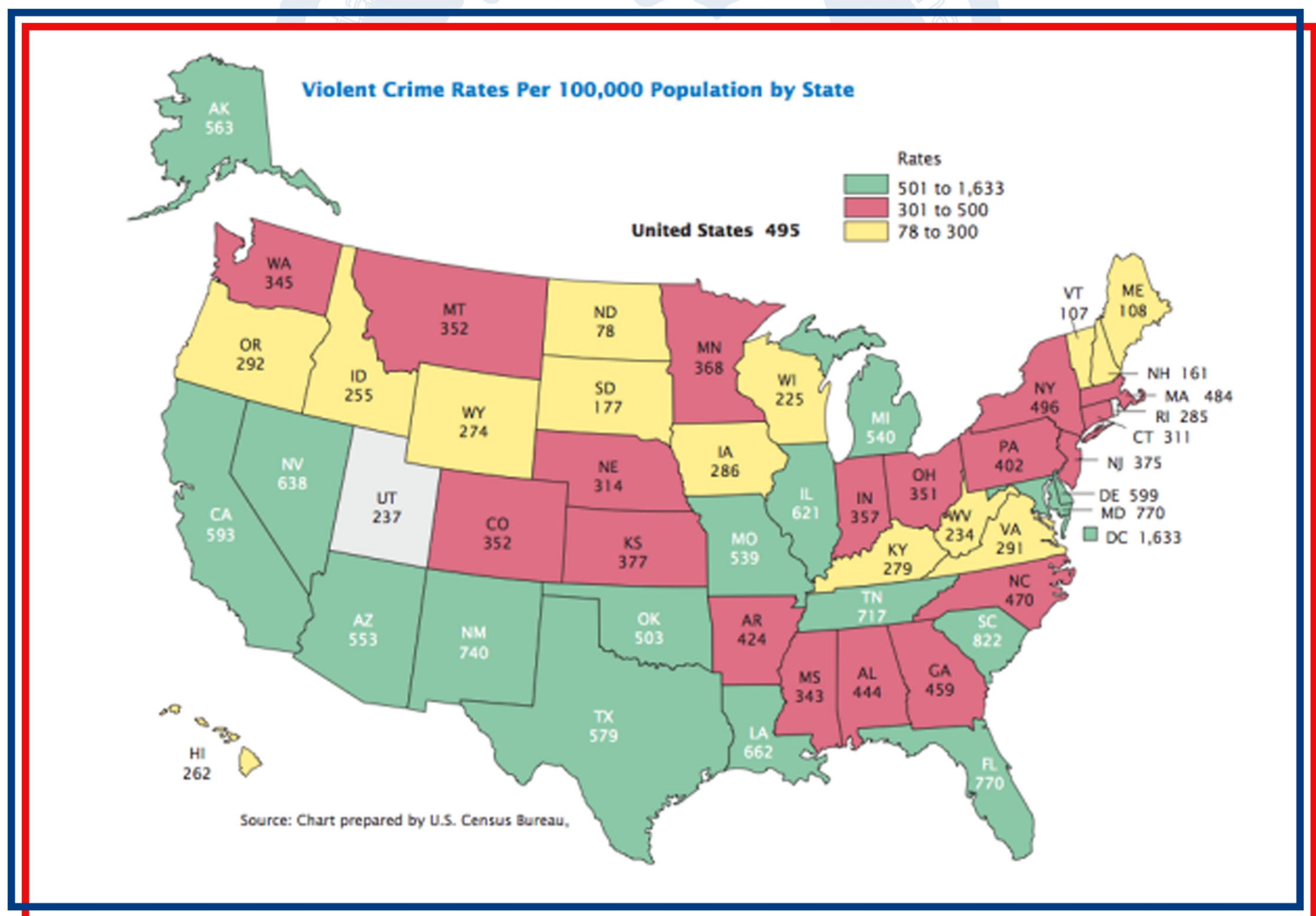
- The total number of murders in the nation was 15,696.
 - ✓ Firearms were utilized in 71.5 percent of the murders, 40.8 percent of robberies, and 24.2 percent of severe assaults.
- Last year, there were almost 90,185 rapes cases.

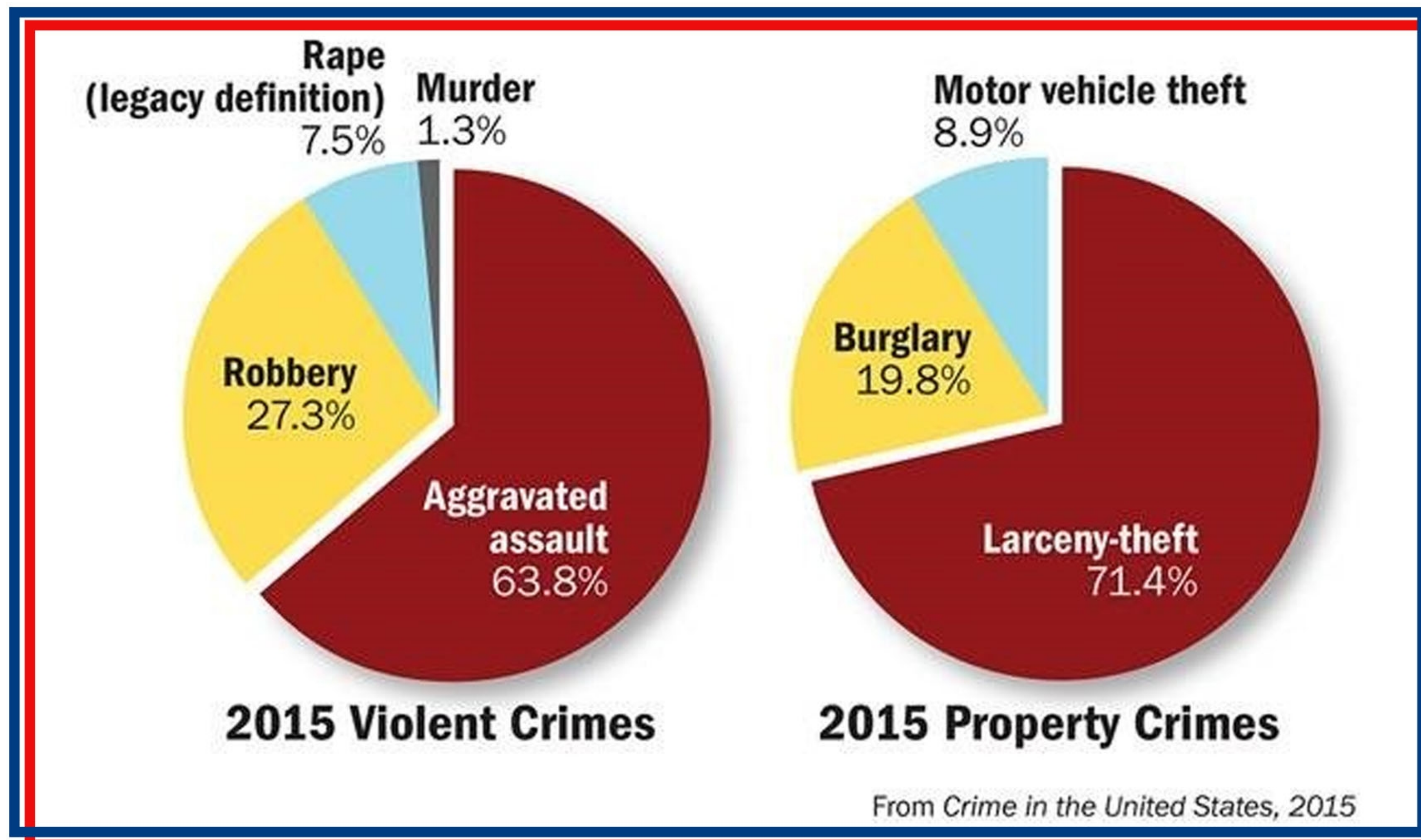


Some other reports have also showed that the crime happening in other states, which is presented below:

- Anchorage, Alaska has a population of 301,239 while the crimes rate reported was 1070 that is quite a big number, which means 35 out every 1000 people can be subjected to crime.
- In District of Columbia, Washington where population is 672,228, crime rate was reported to be 1202, which equals to 17 in every 1000 people can be a crime victim.
- New York is one of the biggest states of the US. Buffalo has a population of 258,096 with a crimes reported of 1118.6, the chances is very high 43 out every 1000 person is vulnerable to crime.
- Miami, Florida has a population of 437,969 and a crime rate 1021.3, for every 1000 people, 23 persons can be subjected to criminal victimization.

Alaska has highest crime rates followed by Nevada, Tennessee and New Mexico.

Can Martial Arts Reduce Crime Statistics?

- ▶ A study was conducted by the company, Model Mugging where they surveyed 60,000 of their female students and found that after training (more intense than the standard self-defense class), 98.3% of their students were able to avoid assaults altogether. These results are astonishing. Of those who were assaulted, 97% were able to fight off their attacker, 80% of those were able to use voice and body language alone and did not resort to violence.



- ▶ Hence, Martial Arts can be used to bridge a gap between intolerant criminal acts & tolerating the intolerance. Martial arts is a way of life- a way of using physical activity to reduce crime & teach criminals a lesson and stop horrifying people with their dirty & shameful acts of murder, kidnap, rape & abuse etc. The simple & swift techniques of Martial Arts are useful for anyone & everyone regardless of age, sex or creed.
- ▶ The best way to protect yourself in a violent situation is to self-defend. As it is evident from above statistics of increasing violence in U.S, we all can face violence at one point or another of our life and we all should be ready to cope with it. - Find sponsors and vendors



- Register your city as a city on the National Stop the Violence Campaign, and pay the registration fee. The registration fee for each city is \$10,000.
